DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Chico Basin Ranch is located approximately 35 minutes from the Colorado Springs airport, 2.5 hours from Denver International Airport.

From I-25: Take Exit 122 east to Old Pueblo road (frontage road) , following signs to Hanover. Hard right just north of the Fountain Creek bridge to Hanover Road. Follow Hanover Road approximately 13 miles east to Peyton Highway (stop sign). Right (south) on Peyton Highway one mile to Chico Basin Ranch gate. Ranch headquarters is 4 miles south of the gate.

Chico is an 87,000-acre working cattle ranch 35 minutes southeast of Colorado Springs, Colorado. It is owned by the Colorado State Land Board and managed under a one-of-a-kind lease by Duke and Janet Phillips and their family. The ranch offers education and recreation for adults and children. From the Chico gate entrance (dirt roads from here on) proceed 1 mile to wooden cowboy cutout (Howdy sign). Take a sharp right turn and go .8 mile to wooden deer cutout. Left .4 miles to hunt test staging area. We will also have easy to follow signs out on the road. Coffee and donuts will be available in the morning; water and soft drinks throughout the day. See reservation below for western barbeque following the judging.

Entry fee is \$15.00 per dog entered. Make checks payable to the Timberline Basset Hound Club. Individual Hounds may be entered in more than one stake at this test. Hounds entered in brace and pack stakes need not have the same owners.

This test is open to all Basset Hounds, Beagles, Dachshunds and Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen registered with the American Kennel Club and those having valid ILP numbers. Spayed and neutered hounds may compete in this test.

Stakes offered: Solo, Brace and Two-Coupled Pack

Type of game: Rabbit

Awards: Rosettes with BHCA logo will be awarded to all qualifying hounds. A certificate with Basset's name, owner's name, judges, date and BHCA logo will be prepared and mailed to all qualifying hounds.

Exhibitor Information: Colored collars will be available at the test to identify Hounds in brace and 2-coupled pack stakes if needed. Collars are courtesy of John Miller, Paris, France. Bassets will be judged individually in each stake.

Breakfast and lunch will be available in the hospitality building. **Spectators are encouraged to participate.**

Each entry must specify "Q" or "NQ" indicating whether or not that stake is to count toward a title. Only one "Q" may be submitted at each test. In a BHCA sanctioned test, a Hunting Hound (HH), Senior Hunting Hound (SHH), Master Hunting Hound (MHH), or Master Hunter Excellent (MHE) title may be earned. A dog qualifying in either solo, brace, or 2-coupled pack at a trial can earn an HH. Once having the HH, the dog must compete in one of the other remaining stakes for its SHH, and then in the final remaining stake to earn an MHH and MHE.

Hounds will be judged using the following categories of hunting ability: (1) ability to find, (2) use of voice when applicable for that breed, (3) line ability, (4) adaptability, (5) determination on a scale of 1 to 10; (6) gun shyness is judged on a pass/no pass basis. In order to pass this test, a dog must score an average of 6 for all categories when all judges' scores are tallied.

Notice to Exhibitors

This trial is open to all Beagles, Dachshunds, Basset Hounds and Petit Basset Griffon Vendéen over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive hounds, hounds suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the hound's physical or mental performance.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owners or handlers of each dog are solely responsible for being ready to perform.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when being tested. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guests and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s), guests or children create unnecessary disturbances or reportedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees will be made.

Bitches in season are not permitted at this test, and entries will be refunded if bitch entered in solo stake is in season at time of trial. If a bitch in season has been registered in brace or 2-coupled pack stakes, another basset hound may be substituted.

Two-way radios will be used at this test.

Faxed, telephoned or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.
